Project Summary

Under a continuing services contract, ATM is providing the City of Boca Raton support for multiple beach projects including the North Boca Raton Beach Renourishment Project, a federal project within the Jacksonville District. The City is the local sponsor for this project. ATM has provided engineering, permitting, coordination and consultation, and construction administration support.

ATM has coordinated with state and federal regulatory agencies to obtain permit modifications to reduce and streamline biological monitoring efforts. ATM obtained permit modifications for the South Boca Raton Beach Renourishment Project to simplify monitoring protocol in the issued state and federal permits. The North and South Boca Raton Beach Renourishment projects were completed in March 2010. ATM provided complete construction phase services and post-construction biological and physical monitoring services. Post construction monitoring and reporting is also being provided for the 2006 Central Beach Renourishment Project.

ATM is working with the City to perform Florida Department of Environmental Protection and U.S. Army Corps of Engineers ermitting and construction services for a renourishment of all three of the City's beach projects.

Other services include: design, construction and administration of a post Hurricane Sandy emergency dune project, permitting and design for dune overwalk rehabilitation, and review and update of inlet bypassing operations.
